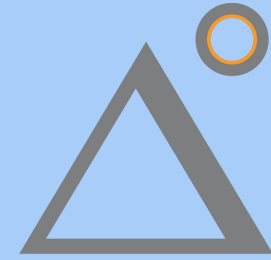

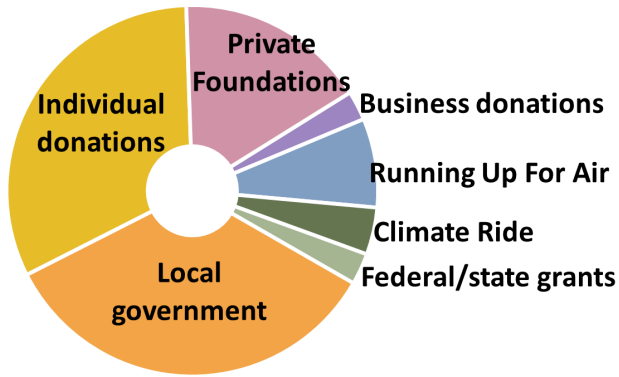

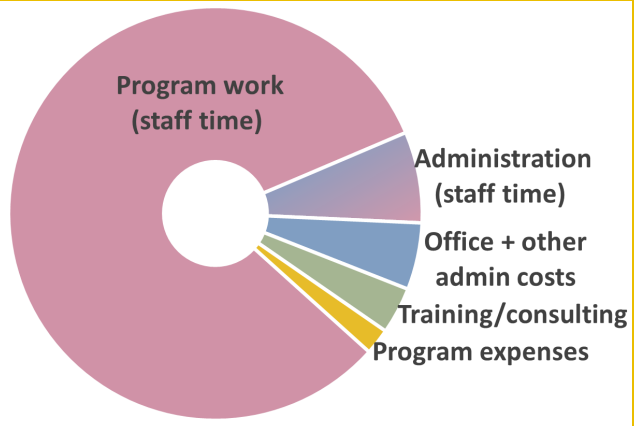


2022 Finances
