2018 Public Tree Inventory

This summer Trees for Missoula (TFM) will assist the urban forestry division in conducting a 5-year update to the 2013 Missoula Public Tree Inventory.

In 2013, urban forestry staff, two interns and TFM volunteers inventoried 20,545 street trees for 14 weeks. Since then, urban forestry staff have been continually updating the inventory, currently up to 29,656 public trees. It is now estimated that Missoula's urban forest consists of 34,000 public trees!
